Job Description:

- Oversee chapel program (both morning and evening chapels).
 - Coordinate and coach worship teams (this includes worship leader, vocals, instruments, media and sound) each week.
 - Plan and prepare setlists or, if you are not leading, assist the worship leader in doing this task.
 - Facilitate worship practices.
 - Lead a daily devotional/prayer time for the worship team.
 - Ensure that media is prepared for chapels.
 - Including lyrics for worship, camp videos and any media that speakers might have.
 - MC and lead morning chapel
- Host the camp speaker.
 - Welcome speaker at the beginning of the week, and connect with them daily regarding order of chapel events, song choices and any media requests.
- Along with Program Coordinator, oversee fireside times.
 - Coordinate drama, music and testimonies for daily firesides.
- Manage the tuck shop
 - Take weekly inventory of all clothing and food
 - Order food products on a weekly basis
 - Run the clothing store during Sunday registration and Friday pick up times
 - train others on the t-shirt press and debit machine
 - Run the tuck shop during tuck time each day
