Job Description

- You must have your NLS, Water Safety and Swim Instruction Qualifications with either AEC or CPR C and First Aid training.
- Must be at least 18 years of age.

General Duties:

- Oversee assistant lifeguards and provide leadership as they grow in their roles.
- Schedule efficient pool supervision throughout the summer.
- Supervise all swimming activities.
 - Plan and oversee swimming skill sessions
 - Oversee free time swimming.
 - Oversee any lake/beach activities
 - Supervise all guest group swimming times (if applicable)
- Maintain accurate pool and program records.
- Be available to assist the medic as needed

Pool Maintenance/Daily Responsibilities

- Work with the Director of Facilities to do regular pool maintenance.
- Complete water analysis according to regulation requirements.
 - Free Chlorine Residual must be taken and recorded when pool is opened and every 3 hours following until pool is closed for the day.
 - PH test must be taken and recorded at least twice daily.
 - Alkalinity test must be taken and recorded once daily.
- Check motor, pumps and filter operations.
- Check chemical feed operations.
- Skim pool manually, back-wash filters, add make-up water, brush pool liner and vacuum pool.
- Place creepy-crawler vacuum in pool for night.
- Uncover and cover the pool each day.
- Turn off solar panel at the end of the day.
- Add chemicals if necessary or ask for assistance in adding chemicals when needed.
 - Notify Director of Facilities if supplies or chemicals are needed.
- Keep pool, deck and pump house areas clean.
- Take inventory once a week of all pool supplies.

Weekly Responsibilities:

- Test and record calcium hardness levels and CYA levels weekly.

General Expectations

- To serve willingly in all areas of camp ministry.
- To be flexible regarding work hours.
- Start work on-time each morning and to be as productive as possible during your work time.
- Participate in camp program (i.e. wide games, chapels, firesides, etc.).
- Come to an appropriate person in leadership with any concerns or questions you may have.
- Treat all campers with respect and help each person who comes to Redberry to have a positive, healthy experience at camp.
- Be a positive example for campers to follow.
- Commit to make an effort to grow in your personal relationship with the Lord.
