- Respect and work well with the Sr. Cabin Leader who is working alongside you.

- Attend one staff meeting per day.
- Complete camper follow-up forms and birthday cards for each camper, each week.
- Meet with head cabin leader each week.

- Participate in camp program when able (this includes wide games, firesides, etc.).
