Job Description

- Must be a minimum of 18 years old.
- Responsible for providing proper health care for campers and staff onsite at camp.
- Responsible for the storage and distribution of camper/staff medication. Must be aware of what parents have authorized for their child in terms of medication.
 - Tracking distribution of all medication (PRN, prescriptions, etc.)
- Responsible for medication and first aid inventory.
- Responsible to be the first responder on site when any incident may occur.
 - In charge of making decisions regarding further health care for the injured person.
- Must communicate with the directors about possible issues or needs of staff and campers.
 - Must prepare incident reports for all incidents in a timely matter.
- Must communicate with cabin staff regarding campers with special medical needs each week.
- Must always be available at main camp site area throughout the week.
 - Communicate with camp directors every time you are leaving the main camp site areas.
- Assist in providing extra attention and care to homesick campers.
- At minimum, must have <u>First Aid and CPR training</u>.

General Expectations

- To serve willingly in all areas of camp ministry.
- To be flexible regarding work hours.
- Start work on-time each morning and to be as productive as possible during your work time
- Participate in camp program when able (this includes wide games, firesides, etc.).
- Come to an appropriate person in leadership with any concerns or questions you may have.
