Job Description:

- Plan and lead one week of Outback Boy's Camp

- Responsible to care for and lead the 10-15 boys who are a part of the Outback program for the week.
- Responsible for overseeing food plans for the Outback program.
 - Plan a suitable menu (meet with Head Cook)
 - Create a cooking schedule/plan.
 - Ensure there are adequate resources to prepare, cook and serve the food at the Outback location.
- Assist in getting the Outback location ready for campers, and gathering/organizing supplies.
- Lead and communicate with other outback camp staff
 - Communicate with and orient outback staff before camp starts.
 - Run staff meetings each morning.
 - Delegate and assign tasks to other Outback Camp staff.
 - Give appropriate feedback to Outback Camp staff members who lead activities, lessons, etc.
 - Organize time off during the week for the Outback staff
- Responsible to be a spiritual leader to campers and facilitate devotional times.

- To serve willingly in all areas of camp ministry.
- To be flexible regarding work hours.
- Start work on-time each morning and to be as productive as possible during your work time.
- Participate in camp program when able (this includes wide games, firesides, etc.).

- Be a positive example for campers to follow.
