Job Description

- Must be a spiritual leader to your campers and facilitate creative and biblical oriented cabin devotions 2x/day .
 - Work to provide opportunities for campers to respond to the gospel and grow spiritually.
- Build relationships with children/youth in your cabin.
- Assist in and participate in all scheduled Riding Camp activities, skills and events.
 - This includes rides & skills at the barn (as skill level permits), skills at main camp, chapels, firesides, etc.
 - Lead skills and activities when asked.
- Lead, respect and encourage co-staff member who is working alongside you.
- Attend barn staff meeting each day.
- Complete camper follow-up forms and birthday cards for each camper, each week.
- Encourage, respect and comply with the Riding Camp Coordinator.

General Expectations

- To serve willingly in all areas of camp ministry.
- To be flexible regarding work hours.
- Start work on-time each morning and to be as productive as possible during your work time.
- Come to an appropriate person in leadership with any concerns or questions you may have.
- Treat all campers with respect and help each person who comes to Redberry to have a positive, healthy experience at camp.
- Be a positive example for campers to follow.
- Commit to make an effort to grow in your personal relationship with the Lord.
