Job Description

- Lead and communicate with other Riding Camp staff and volunteers.

 - Run staff meetings each morning.
 - Delegate and assign tasks to other Riding Camp staff.
 - Give appropriate feedback to Riding Camp staff members who lead activities, lessons, etc.
 - Communicate with the speaker on a daily basis.
 - Communicate with whoever is making meals for Riding Camp.
- Keep schedule running on time.
- Help get the Riding Camp site ready for camp.
- Responsible for knowing supply inventory and the camp site clean-up at the end of summer.
